Subject: MasoniCh.I.P Clinic

The Masons of the Grand Lodge of Canada, in the Province of Ontario, have long held a commitment to the children, their families, and our community. Our **MasoniCh.I.P.** Program is the most comprehensive child identification service currently available, which is designed to give families a measure of protection against the ever-increasing problem of missing children. It is brought exclusively to Ontario families by Masons, **free of charge** and has endorsement from the Parliamentary Secretary for the Minister of Public Safety, Amber Alert, as well as overwhelming support of the Ontario Provincial Police.

The program consists of five major components: vital child information, digital fingerprints, digital photographs, a digital video and a dental bite impression. All of this data is burned onto a CD, and given to the parents or guardian. Security and privacy are of the utmost importance, therefore it is significant to note that the Ontario Masons keep nothing on file, with the exception of the permission form signed by the parent, prior to participation in the event.

It is our sincerest hope that no family will need the resources provided in our packets, but if the need should arise, we believe the information that we provide from our program will be instrumental to law enforcement agencies in the recovery of a missing child. It takes less than **2 minutes** from the time the CD-Rom is loaded into the Police computer for the AMBER ALERT broadcast to be sent through their system.

The clinic is scheduled to run from 0900 to 1700 on Saturday January 24th in the main foyer of the Innisfil Recreation Centre which is located at 7315 Yonge Street in Innisfil. The public is encouraged to promote the event to their friends and family and bring as many children as possible to the event.
